

INITIAL CASE PLAN
JULY 20, 2020

1. Janet Morgan shall participate in a substance abuse assessment and follow any recommendations for treatment generated from that assessment. The Department of Child and Family Services (Department) shall arrange for Janet Morgan's substance abuse assessment and receive the results of the assessment and treatment recommendations.
2. The Department shall make efforts to locate Mr. Raymond Capa.
3. When Mr. Capa is located, the Department shall attempt to receive copies of any recent mental health/substance abuse assessments or treatment progress reports. If no such records exist or if records are not current within 6 months, Mr. Capa shall participate in a substance abuse assessment and follow any recommendations for treatment generated from that assessment. The Department shall arrange for a substance abuse assessment and receive the results of the assessment and treatment recommendations.
4. The Department shall make efforts to obtain records concerning Justin Roger's treatment and any program participation from the Mock State Correctional Facility.
5. The Department shall arrange for supervised visitation between Janet Morgan and Kerry, Layla, and Jessica Morgan. Frequency and duration shall be determined by the Department based on observation and supervision.
6. Justin Rogers shall sign any required consent to release all treatment and program participation records to the Department.
7. Once Raymond Capa is located, the Department shall arrange for supervised visitation between Raymond Capa and Kerry and Layla Morgan. Frequency and duration shall be determined by the Department based on results of Mr. Capa's assessments and in consultation with the children's Guardian ad Litem.
8. The Department shall arrange for supervised visitation or other forms of contact if visitation is not possible between Justin Rogers and Jessica Morgan. Frequency and duration shall be determined by the Department based on results of information collected from Mock State Correctional Facility and in consultation with the children's Guardian ad Litem.

September 21, 2020

1. Kerry Morgan, Layla Morgan, and Jessica Morgan shall remain in the legal and physical custody of the Department of Child and Family Services (Department).
2. The Department shall continue to make efforts to locate Janet Morgan.
3. Janet Morgan shall participate in a substance abuse assessment and follow any recommendations for treatment generated from that assessment. The Department shall arrange for Janet Morgan's substance abuse assessment and receive the results of the assessment and treatment recommendations.
4. The Department shall continue to make efforts to locate Raymond Capa.
5. The Department shall attempt to receive copies of any recent mental health/substance abuse assessments or treatment progress reports. If no such records exist or if records are not current within 6 months, Mr. Capa shall participate in a substance abuse assessment and follow any recommendations for treatment generated from that assessment. The Department shall arrange for a substance abuse assessment and receive the results of the assessment and treatment recommendations.
6. The Department shall ensure that Kerry, Layla, and Jessica Morgan have routine, ongoing physical health care and dental services and shall follow up with any recommendations made.
7. The Department shall ensure that Kerry, Layla, and Jessica Morgan maintain enrollment in school and shall ensure that any educational assistance and support required by the children is provided.
8. The Department shall monitor Layla Morgan's progress in therapeutic foster care placement and ensure that she receives all necessary services as identified by the provider.
9. The Department shall provide visitation between Kerry, Layla, and Jessica Morgan. The frequency and conditions of visitation shall be determined by the Department in consultation with the children's providers.
10. Justin Rogers shall continue counseling and parenting classes available at the Mock State Correctional Facility.
11. Justin Rogers may write to Jessica Morgan. The Department shall review and monitor all communications for appropriateness.
12. Once Janet Morgan is located, the Department shall arrange for supervised visitation between Janet Morgan and Kerry, Layla, and Jessica Morgan. Frequency and duration shall be determined by the Department based results of her assessments.
13. Once Raymond Capa is located, the Department shall arrange for supervised visitation between Raymond Capa and Kerry and Layla Morgan. Frequency and duration shall be determined by the Department based on results of Mr. Capa's assessments and in consultation with the children's Guardian ad Litem.

2. Janet Morgan shall have visitation with Kerry Morgan, Layla Morgan, and Jessica Morgan. Frequency, duration, and level of supervision shall be determined by the Department.
3. Raymond Capa shall have visitation with Kerry Morgan and Layla Morgan. Frequency, duration, and level of supervision shall be determined by the Department.
4. The Department shall explore with the Mock State Correctional Facility the feasibility of supervised telephone contact between Justin Rogers and Jessica Morgan. The Department shall arrange for such visitation if it is feasible.
5. The Department shall arrange for Kerry, Layla, and Jessica Morgan to have ongoing routine physical health care and dental services and shall follow up with any recommendations made.
6. The Department shall ensure that Kerry, Layla, and Jessica Morgan maintain enrollment in school and shall ensure that any educational assistance and support required is provided.
7. Janet Morgan shall continue in her in-patient treatment program and follow all discharge recommendations.
8. Raymond Capa shall continue to participate in outpatient therapy to address his mental illness and substance abuse.
9. Raymond Capa shall participate in random drug testing as determined by the Department.
10. Justin Rogers shall continue to participate in counseling and parenting classes at Mock State Correctional Facility.
11. Justin Rogers shall continue to communicate with Jessica Morgan by mail.

1. Kerry Morgan, Layla Morgan, and Jessica Morgan shall remain in the legal and physical custody of the Department of Child and Family Services (Department).

3. Once Janet Morgan is located, she shall participate in a substance abuse reassessment and follow any recommendations for treatment generated from that reassessment. At a minimum, Janet Morgan shall participate in random drug testing as determined by the Department. The Department shall arrange for Janet Morgan's substance abuse reassessment and receive the results of the reassessment and treatment recommendations.
4. Raymond Capa shall continue to participate in outpatient therapy to address his mental health and substance abuse.
5. Raymond Capa shall participate in random drug testing as determined by the Department.
6. Once Janet Morgan is located, the Department shall develop a visitation plan for Ms. Morgan and her children. Frequency, duration, and level of supervision shall be determined by the Department.
7. Raymond Capa shall have visitation with Kerry Morgan and Layla Morgan. Frequency, duration, and level of supervision shall be determined by the Department.
8. The Department shall arrange for Kerry, Layla, and Jessica Morgan to have ongoing routine physical health care and dental services and shall follow up with any recommendations made.
9. The Department shall provide Mock Tribe with any and all documents or information needed for Mock Tribe to determine Kerry Morgan and Layla Morgan's membership eligibility.
10. The Department shall continue to monitor and facilitate telephone and letter contact between Justin Rogers and Jessica Morgan.
