His wife has given them food because they look hungry. Ms. Johnson said she has also taken the children in from time to time in the evening and given them some food. The children always have eventually gone home as Kerry says their mother would be worried.

Two men were fighting in front of the home. The neighbor reported the men had knives and were yelling at each other. Two of the children were in the yard watching. Police found Ms. Morgan incoherent on the couch. She was arrested for possession of drug paraphernalia and a small amount of a substance thought to be heroin. Police found several bottles of oxycodone with prescription labels belonging to others. She was unable to give the name of someone who could care for the children. He said that recently they have been receiving quite a few calls concerning this address – usually noise complaints, suspicious characters. A known drug dealer has been seen at the home. Told Office Henry that I would be arriving shortly.
